Truly loving Jesus Christ produces obedience to His word. - John 14:23-24



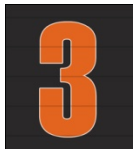
### Fantasy success is worthless.

### A fantasy relationship is dangerous.

You have to actually know someone in order to hang out with them.

In real relationships, both parties know each other - John 10:14-15

If you don't know God, you can't go to His house and fellowship with Him - Matthew 7:15-23

You can have a legit relationship with God, through Jesus Christ - John 7:37, Matthew 11:28-30
