

## Week 9: Playing With Aggression



### An aggressive offense makes big plays.

Think big, play smart and give it everything.

Don't settle for average – Luke 12:29, Ephesians 3:20

Attack with forcefulness, not anger, malice or violence – Matthew 11:12, 2 Corinthians 10:5

Do everything with your full effort – Colossians 3:23



### An aggressive defense shuts down the opposition.

Don't give an inch to enemy; instead, take things away.

Like a defense busts up offensive plays, we destroy the works of the enemy – 2 Cor 10:5, Romans 12:21

We can break through the “offensive line” of the enemy – Matthew 16:8

The “safety” when our defense makes a mistake is the grace of Jesus Christ – Romans 5:15-21



### The direction of the aggression makes the difference.

Love God, hate sin.

Our attitude toward people should be full of grace and love – Ephesians 3:2, John 15:12

Our attitude toward evil should be forceful and intolerant – Psalm 119:104, Romans 12:9

When the good guys win, it's better for everyone – Proverbs 28:12

Get aggressive! Allow God to grow a passion in you for doing what is right. Treat sin like a cancer, while reaching out in love to those who are dying from it.
