You have been given a gift by God – 1 Peter 4:10; 1 Cor 12:7

We have different responsibilities, but we're on the same team – 1 Corinthians 12:4-6; Romans 11:36

Not everyone has the same gift – Eph 4:11-12; Romans 12:4-6



Gifts have rules.

Your gift must reflect God's own character – Jeremiah 23:16, Matthew 24:24, 1 John 4:1

Your gift must serve God and others (not you) – Matthew 6:1; 1 Peter 4:10

Your gift must not conflict with God's principles in His Word – Ezekiel 22:28, 2 Peter 2:1

Spiritual gifts impact other believers – Romans 1:11-12

Whatever your gift is, use it to the max – Romans 12:6-8
